
SAP (Special Attrition Program) Survey

As part of the 2023 National Negotiations, management and the UAW leadership agreed to conduct a survey in December to enable "Traditional" employees to express interest in participating in a Special Attrition Program (SAP). The SAP survey is intended to capture eligible employee's interest in the program and preferred timing.

This initial survey is not binding, but it will allow leadership to collect the employee's interest and preferred timing of separation. Expressing interest now does not guarantee participation. An official process communicated at a later date. Only eligible employee are able to express interest.

Union Benefit Representatives (UBR's), Group Leaders, Local HR and People Services have been granted access in workday to express interest on behalf of eligible employees.

The Survey will be available until 11:59pm January 8, 2024. Only interested employees need to complete the survey. Those that express interest can also modify their responses up until the survey close date, their latest submission will be considered.

WHAT IS FREE SHIPPING DAY?

What's not to love about Free Shipping Day held this year on December 14? You can shop 'til you drop by getting everything online; plus, there are no sky-high shipping rates. Pay only for what you actually buy, let someone else handle the extra costs. The date of the holiday changes each year so be on the lookout in mid-December.

FREE SHIPPING DAY HISTORY

Free Shipping Day is a national shopping holiday as well as a year-round coupon website. The holiday started in 2008, while the coupon portion of the site was launched in 2017 as a resource for online savings, providing shoppers with coupons and free shipping codes from top retail partners and niche e-retailers.

National Free Shipping Day was conceived by internet entrepreneur Luke Knowles. While running his own free shipping-focused website, he noticed an interesting trend among users: online shopping seemed to drop around December 10. Though many retailers were capable of shipping orders on time for the holidays, shoppers were worried about receiving their packages on time and the crazy holiday shipping fees that would accompany them. It struck him that an event promoting free shipping and guaranteed on-time delivery was exactly what the holiday season was missing.

The first event was put together in two weeks by Luke and his one employee. It featured 250 participating merchants, including Target, JCPenney, and Pottery Barn. After a busy and sleepless night on December 17, 2008, Knowles kicked off the first ever Free Shipping Day the following morning. The event earned \$764 million in online sales and became one of the top 10 highest-earning days in e-commerce during the holiday season that year!

National Free Shipping Day is now a permanent entry in the holiday shopping lexicon. More and more retailers partner with Free Shipping Day to capture sales from shoppers eager to finish their holiday lists in mid to late December.

IT'S A WINNING IDEA

National Free Shipping Day is the brainchild of Colorado entrepreneur Luke Knowles — who noticed that online shopping slowed to a crawl just before the middle of December. He discovered that shoppers were afraid orders wouldn't arrive in time for Christmas and there would be astronomical shipping fees as well. Knowles solved the problem by creating National Free Shipping Day, a one-day online event that consistently blows out Black Friday sales — meaning a win for both merchants and consumers.
