BACK TO SCHOOL SAFETY

DRIVERS

Watch for pedestrians!

Especially children walking on the treet or congregating near bus stops

Be alert. Children arriving late for the bus may dart into the street without looking

Yellow flashing lights indicate that the bus is preparing to stop to load/unload children. Motorists should slow down and prepare to stop

Red flashing lights and extended stop arms indicate that the bus has stopped, and children are getting on or off.

Motorists must stop their cars

their cars and wait until the red lights stop flashing, the extended stop sign is withdrawn, and the bus begins

moving before driving again.

CHILDREN

Crossing any road is dangerous!

- Get to the bus stop ahead of time
- When the bus approaches, stand at least three giant steps (6 feet) away from the curb, and line up away from the street.
- If you have to cross the street in front of the bus, walk along the side of the road (least five giant steps) ahead before you cross.
- Be sure that the bus driver can see you & you can see the driver.
- Never walk behind the bus.
- Walk at least three giant steps away from the side of the bus.

Rite Aid Pharmacies have been closing due to a Chapter 11 bankruptcy. The Defiance and Napoleon locations are two of the latest locations to close. They are transferring prescriptions to Walgreens Pharmacies. Unfortunately, Walgreens is not an in-network provider for our prescription plan. If you have any current prescriptions with Rite Aid, you will need to contact an in-network pharmacy and have them request the prescription be sent to them or have your doctor write a script to the new pharmacy.
