1889 Savings Bank of Order of True Reformers opens in Richmond, Virginia


1910 Highest mountain in North America, Alaska's Mt McKinley claimed to have been 1st climbed by 4 local men



Scoring Process Explained





Respondents who answered Strongly Agree (5) or Agree (4) to question(s) Score (%) Total # Respondents who answered question(s)

- Each question is asked on a five-point scale, with 1 being "Strongly Disagree" and 5 being "Strongly Agree."
- To calculate the index, the total number of "favorable" responses (i.e., agree or strongly agree) is divided by the total number of responses.

The survey takes about 10-15 minutes to complete.




Participation is 100% voluntary. Every voice will have equal weight.
